AN ACT to apply out of the Consolidated Revenue a sum for the Service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-four. [20 April, 1953.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1 This Act may be cited as the Supply Act 1953-54.

Short title.

2 There shall and may be issued and applied towards Issue and making good the supply hereby granted to Her Majesty for £2,519,610. the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-four, the sum of two million five hundred and nineteen thousand six hundred and ten pounds out of the Consolidated Revenue, for the purposes and services expressed in the schedule to this Act; and the Treasurer is hereby authorised and empowered to issue and apply the moneys authorised to be issued and applied.

- 3 The said sum shall be available to satisfy the warrants sum avail-under the hand of the Governor in respect of any purposes purposes set forth in the said schedule. and services set forth in the said schedule.
- 4 The Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his accounts credit to be for any sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any given to the such warrant as aforesaid; and the receipts of the respective accounts. persons to whom the same are so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the Treasurer in passing his said accounts for any such sums as are therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
