No. 81 of 1953.

AN ACT to amend the *Shops Act 1925*.
[9 December, 1953.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title
and citation.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Shops Act 1953*.

(2) The *Shops Act 1925*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Small shops.

2 Section twelve of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by inserting in subsection (6) thereof, after the word “firm”, the words “(not being a partnership the sole partners in which are a person and his spouse or a person and his child)”; and
- (b) by inserting after that subsection the following subsection:—

“(6A) No shopkeeper, being a partnership registered under subsection (6), shall engage or employ in a shop that is registered as a small shop more than one shop assistant (being a member of the family of one of the members of the partnership).”.
