AN ACT to apply out of the Consolidated Revenue a sum for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June 1955. [28 April, 1954.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the Supply Act 1954-55.

Short title.

2 There may be issued and applied towards making good Issue and the supply hereby granted to Her Majesty for the service of of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June 1955 the £2,791,850. sum of £2,791,350 out of the Consolidated Revenue, for the purposes and services expressed in the schedule, and the Treasurer is authorized to issue and apply the moneys so authorized to be issued and applied.

3 The sum specified in section two shall be available to Sum available satisfy the warrants under the hand of the Governor in purposes set respect of any purposes and services set forth in the schedule. Sum available for the purposes set forth in the schedule.

4 The Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his accounts Credit to be for any sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any Treasurer in warrant mentioned in section three, and the receipts of the accounts. respective persons to whom any sums of money are so paid are a full and valid discharge to the Treaurer in passing his accounts for such sums as are therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for them accordingly.
