AN ACT to apply out of the Consolidated Revenue 1940. a Sum for the Service of the year ending the Thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and [15 November, 1940.] forty-one.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania. by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-
