AN ACT supplementary to the Acts for appropriating certain Sums arising from the Consolidated Revenue to the Service of the State of Tasmania for the Year ended the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-four.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

2 The sum of one hundred and sixty-two thousand eight hundred and seventy-one pounds and nine pence, which has been issued from the consolidated revenue of the State of Tasmania for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-four, for the several purposes specified in the schedule to this Act, shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of the Appropriation Act 1933-34, for the purposes and services expressed in the schedule to this Act.
