ANALYSIS.

1. Short title.
2. Amendment of 26 Geo. V. No. 41, s. 22.

AN ACT to amend the *State Advances Act* 1935. A.D. 1940.
[31 October, 1940.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *State Advances Act* 1940. Short title.

2 The Principal Act is hereby amended by inserting at the end of section twenty-two thereof the following new subsections (4) and (5)— Amendment of 26 Geo. V. No. 41, s. 22

“(4) Where any land which has reverted to the Crown, as herein provided, is required for the purposes of the *Forestry Act* 1920, the Governor, by proclamation, may reserve the same from sale, and declare the same to be a reserve for the purposes of that Act; and thereupon the provisions of subsection (2) hereof shall cease to apply to such land while such proclamation is in force.

State Advances.

A.D. 1940. (5) The Governor, by such proclamation, may direct that the Conservator of Forests shall pay to the Board such amount, and from such source, as may be specified in such proclamation as consideration for such reservation, and the amount so paid shall be applied as provided by subsection (3) hereof in like manner as if the same were purchase money.”.
