AN ACT to amend the *State Advances Act* 1935. A.D. 1941.  
[17 June, 1941.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania,  
 by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative  
 Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as  
 follows:—

**1** This Act may be cited as the *State Advances Act* 1941. Short title.

*State Advances.*

A.D. 1941. **2** Section thirty-six of the Principal Act is hereby amended—

- I. By deleting all the words after “within” in subsection (7) to the end of the subsection, and substituting therefor the words “such period as the Board may determine in each case”:
- II. By adding at the end of the section the following new subsection (12):—

“(12) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, the purposes for which the Board may make advances under this Part shall include financial assistance to persons engaged in operations in connection with the fisheries of the State (other than the salmon and freshwater fisheries), including the taking, handling, preserving, processing, or disposing of fish.”.

**3** The advances made by the Board to persons who suffered losses through crop failures on account of adverse climatic conditions in the months of December one thousand nine hundred and thirty-four, and January, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-five, shall be deemed to have been validly made, and it shall be deemed to have been lawful for the Board to make such advances free of interest.

**4—(1)** The Board, out of moneys available under Part IV. of the Principal Act, may make advances, not exceeding in the whole the sum of two thousand pounds, to the Royal Agricultural Society of Tasmania, for the purposes of additions and improvements to that Society’s show-ground at Glenorchy.

(2) The provisions of Part IV. of the Principal Act, so far as the same are applicable, shall apply to the advances authorised by this section.
