

SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION, 1952-53.

No. 25 of 1953.

AN ACT to appropriate a further sum from the Consolidated Revenue for the service of the year ended on the thirtieth day of June, 1953. [20 October, 1953.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Supplementary Appropriation Act 1952-53*. Short title.

2 The sum of £154,479 7s. 2d., that has been issued from the Consolidated Revenue for the service of the year ended on the thirtieth day of June, 1953, shall be deemed to have been appropriated, as from the first day of July, 1952, for the purposes and services expressed in the schedule. FRUITGROWERS' DEFENCE FUND.

No. 26 of 1953.

AN ACT to amend the *Fruitgrowers' Defence Fund Act 1945.* [23 October, 1953.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Fruitgrowers' Defence Fund Act 1953.*

(2) The *Fruitgrowers' Defence Fund Act 1945* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
