AN ACT to appropriate a further sum from the Consolidated Revenue for the service of the year ended on the thirtieth day of June 1956. [26 November 1956.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:---

Short title.

1 This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Act 1955-1956.

Appropriation of £367,402 11s.

2 The sum of £367,402 11s. 7d., that has been issued from the Consolidated Revenue for the service of the year ended on the thirtieth day of June 1956, shall be deemed to have been appropriated, as from the first day of July 1955, for the purposes and services expressed in the schedule.
