AN ACT to appropriate a further sum from the Consolidated Revenue for the service of the year ended on the thirtieth day of June 1957.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Act may be cited as the *Supplementary Appropriation Act 1956-1957*.
