SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION 1961-1962.

No. 43 of 1962.

AN ACT to appropriate a further sum from the Consolidated Revenue for the service of the year ended on the thirtieth day of June 1962.

[15 November 1962.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Supplementary Appropriation Act 1961-1962*. Short title.

2 The sum of £1,017,358 17s. 11d., that has been issued from the Consolidated Revenue for the service of the year ended on the thirtieth day of June 1962, shall be deemed to have been appropriated, as from the first day of July 1961, for the purposes and services expressed in the first schedule. Appropriation of £1,017,358 17s. 11d.

3 The expenditure of the respective sums of money specified in the third column of the second schedule in respect of the purposes respectively specified opposite those sums in the first column of that schedule is approved. Approval of certain expenditure from advance to Treasurer.
