

**SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION
1963-1964.**

No. 29 of 1964.

AN ACT to appropriate a further sum from the Consolidated Revenue for the service of the year ended on the thirtieth day of June 1964.

[17 November 1964.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Supplementary Appropriation Act 1963-1964.* Short title.

2 The sum of £181,378 10s. 5d., that has been issued from the Consolidated Revenue for the service of the year ended on the thirtieth day of June 1964, shall be deemed to have been appropriated, as from the first day of July 1963, for the purposes and services expressed in the schedule. Appropriation of £181,378 10s. 5d.
