AN ACT to amend the Sheriff Act 1873 for the purpose of allowing the Sheriff to leave the State without obtaining the Governor's permission.

[Royal Assent 21 November 1979]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the Sheriff Amendment Act 1979. Short title.

Commencement.

Amendment of section 1 of Sberiff Act 1873 (Power of Governor to appoint Sheriff to hold office during pleasure). 2—This Act shall commence on the 7th day after the date of assent to this Act.

3—Section 1 of the *Sheriff Act* 1873^* is amended by omitting subsection (2).
