AN ACT to amend the Solicitor-General Act 1983.

[Royal Assent 9 May 1986]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Solicitor-General Amendment Act* 1986. Short title.

2—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives the Royal assent. Commence-
ment.

Principal Act. **3**—In this Act, the *Solicitor-General Act 1983** is referred to as the Principal Act.

4—After section 12 of the Principal Act, the following section is inserted:—

Employees.

12A—(1) Subject to and in accordance with the *Tasmanian State Service Act 1984*, such persons may be appointed or employed as may be necessary to enable the Solicitor-General to perform his functions under this Act.

(2) On being requested by the Solicitor-General to do so, the Secretary of the Law Department may—

(a) provide such employees employed in the Agency of which he is the Head, within the meaning of the *Tasmanian State Service Act 1984*; or

(b) procure the services of such other persons, as may reasonably be necessary for the purposes of assisting the Solicitor-General in the performance of his functions.
