AN ACT to amend the Solicitor-General Act 1983. [Royal Assent 9 May 1986]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—This Act may be cited as the Solicitor-General Amendment Short title. Act 1986.
- **2**—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives the Commence-Royal assent.

Principal Act.

3—In this Act, the *Solicitor-General Act* 1983* is referred to as the Principal Act.

Insertion in Principal Act of new section 12A. **4**—After section 12 of the Principal Act, the following section is inserted:—

Employees.

- 12A—(1) Subject to and in accordance with the *Tasmanian State Service Act* 1984, such persons may be appointed or employed as may be necessary to enable the Solicitor-General to perform his functions under this Act.
- (2) On being requested by the Solicitor-General to do so, the Secretary of the Law Department may—
 - (a) provide such employees employed in the Agency of which he is the Head, within the meaning of the *Tasmanian State Service Act* 1984; or
- (b) procure the services of such other persons, as may reasonably be necessary for the purposes of assisting the Solicitor-General in the performance of his functions.
