AN ACT to amend the Solicitor-General Act 1983.

 \mathbf{B}^{E} it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the Solicitor-General Amendment Short title. Act 1988.

2—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives Commencement. the Royal assent.

Principal Act.

Amendment of Schedule 1 to Principal Act (PENSION

RIGHTS, &c.).

3—In this Act, the Solicitor-General Act 1983* is referred to as the Principal Act.

4—Schedule 1 to the Principal Act is amended as follows:—

- (a) by inserting after "this clause" in clause 1 (3) "and sums paid under clause 7 (2)";
- (b) by inserting after "Solicitor-General" in clause 5 (1) "(otherwise than on becoming a judge)";
- (c) by omitting from clause 6 "Revenue";
- (d) by omitting from clause 7 "If" and substituting "(1) If";
- (e) by omitting from paragraph (a) of that clause "the period" and substituting "subject to subclause (2), the period";
- (f) by adding at the end of that clause the following subclause:—

(2) Paragraph (a) of subclause (1) does not apply to a person who, having held office as Solicitor-General, has, after the commencement of the Solicitor-General Amendment Act 1988, received a payment under clause 5 (1) and has not, within 1 month of becoming a judge, paid to the Treasurer a sum equal to the payment so received.
