

SEWERS AND DRAINS AMENDMENT ACT 1981

AN ACT to amend the Sewers and Drains Act 1954 for the purpose of removing the right of electors of a municipality to demand a poll with respect to the making by the corporation of that municipality of a separate local rate in respect of the cost of sewerage works.

[Royal Assent 9 December 1981]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the Sewers and Drains Amendment short title. Act 1981. No. 76

Commencement.

Amendment of section 29 of Sewers and Drains Act 1954 (Right of local authority to recover costs of construction of a system). 2—This Act shall commence on the same date as that specified in section 2 (1) of the Local Government Amendment Act (No. 2) 1981.

3—Section 29 of the Sewers and Drains Act 1954* is amended by omitting subsection (3).
