AN ACT to amend certain enactments to make provisions with respect to certain registers kept under those enactments.

[Royal Assent 18 August 1987]

B^E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the Statutory Authorities Short title. (Gazettal of Registration Lists) Act 1987.

Commencement.

2—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives the Royal assent.

Amendment of Acts.

3—Each Act specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 is amended in the manner specified opposite the reference to that Act in column 2 of that Schedule.
