**AN ACT to amend certain enactments to make provisions with respect to certain registers kept under those enactments.**

**[Royal Assent 18 August 1987]**

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—This Act may be cited as the *Statutory Authorities* Short title. *(Gazettal of Registration Lists) Act 1987.*

**2**—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives the Royal assent.
