BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled,
as follows:—

Statutory Authorities Patriotic Contributions.

A.D. 1940. **2** Any authority as defined by the *Statutory Authorities' Administration Act 1937*, with the approval of the Governor, may make contributions and pay out of its revenues to—

Power to authority to make contributions to certain funds for patriotic purposes.

- I. Any fund raised within the British Dominions for the relief of victims of enemy air raids: or
- II. Any other patriotic purpose which the Governor may approve—

such sum not exceeding in the aggregate in any financial year, one per centum of the revenues of such authority for the immediately preceding financial year as the Governor may approve, or one hundred pounds whichever is the greater.

Expiration. **3** This Act shall expire at the expiration of twelve months after the termination of the war with Germany in which His Majesty is at present engaged.
