

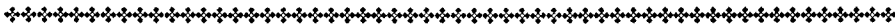

AN ACT to amend the Savings Banks Act 1848.

[31 August 1977]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Savings Banks Act 1977*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Savings Banks Act 1848**, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section 33A of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (2) the words “ of this section shall not exceed two thousand dollars in any one year ” and substituting the words “ by a particular bank in any one year shall not exceed such amount as the Treasurer may, by order, declare ”.
