AN ACT to amend the Savings Banks Act 1848.

[31 August 1977]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Savings Banks Act 1977. Short title and
- (2) The Savings Banks Act 1848*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Power to make donations to charities.

2 Section 33A of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from, subsection (2) the words "of this section shall not exceed two thousand dollars in any one year" and substituting the words "by a particular bank in any one year shall not exceed such amount as the Treasurer may, by order, declare".
