TABLE OF PROVISIONS

AN ACT to amend the Savings Banks Act 1848 for the purpose of making further provision with respect to the power of the committee of a savings bank constituted under that Act to make payments from an amount standing to the credit of a depositor with the bank at the time of his death.

[Royal Assent 19 July 1983]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Savings Banks Amendment Act* Short title. 1983.

2—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives the royal assent.
