AN ACT to amend the Supreme Court Civil Procedure Act 1932.
[Royal Assent 17 April 1985]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Supreme Court Civil Procedure Amendment Act 1985*. Short title.

2—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives the royal assent. Commence-
ment.

3—Section 34 of the *Supreme Court Civil Procedure Act 1932** is amended as follows:—

- (a) by inserting “(1)” before “Upon”;
- (b) by omitting “at a rate not exceeding 7 per centum per annum” and substituting “at the prescribed rate”;
- (c) by adding the following subsection as subsection (2) of that section:—

(2) For the purposes of subsection (1), the prescribed rate is the rate per centum per annum that is from time to time specified in rule 16 of Order 47 of Part I of the Rules of Court.
