AN ACT to amend the Stanley Cool Stores Act 1945.

[Royal Assent 2 September 1988]

DE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, **D** by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

- 1—This Act may be cited as the Stanley Cool Stores Short title. Amendment Act 1988.
- 2—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives Commencement. the Royal assent.

Principal Act.

3—In this Act, the Stanley Cool Stores Act 1945* is referred to as the Principal Act.

Substitution of new section 7 of Principal Act. 4—Section 7 of the Principal Act is repealed and the following section is substituted:—

Appointment of secretary and other officers.

- 7—(1) The board may appoint a secretary to the board and such other officers as it thinks necessary for the purposes of this Act on such terms and conditions as the board may determine.
- (2) An employee, within the meaning of the Tasmanian State Service Act 1984, may hold office under this Act in conjunction with his or her position in the State Service and shall be subject to the directions of the board in the performance of the duties of that office.

Transitional provision.

5—A person who held office under section 7 of the Principal Act immediately before the commencement of the Tasmanian State Service (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act 1984 and who by virtue of clause 29 of Schedule 1 to the Tasmanian State Service (Transitional Provisions) Act 1984 became an employee appointed or employed under the Tasmanian State Service Act 1984 shall be deemed to have been appointed under section 7 of the Principal Act as substituted by this Act.
