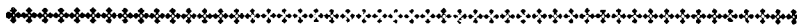

AN ACT to amend the *Stamp Duties Act* 1931. A.D. 1944  
[14 July, 1944.] —

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania,  
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative  
Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled,  
as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Stamp Duties Act* Short title and  
citation.

(2) The *Stamp Duties Act* 1931\*, as subsequently amended,  
is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

A.D. 1944. **2** Section twenty-seven of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection:—

Regulations.

“(2) Provision may be made by regulations under this Act for the collection of duty on cheques from banks carrying on the business of banking in this State, the licensing of such banks for that purpose, the issue, payment, and negotiation of unstamped cheques, and for such incidental matters as may be necessary or convenient in relation thereto.”.

**3** Item 23 in Part IV. of the Second Schedule to the Principal Act is amended by deleting the word “or” in the third column and substituting therefor the word “by”.
