### SECOND-HAND DEALERS.

# AN ACT to amend the Second-hand Dealers Act 1905. [17 January 1973.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

## Short title and citation.

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Second-hand Dealers Act 1972.
- (2) The Second-hand Dealers Act 1905, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

# Licensing of second-hand dealers.

- **2** Section four of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsections (3) and (4) thereof and substituting therefor the following subsections:—
- "(3) A licence under this Act shall, unless sooner cancelled, remain in force for a period of one year from the date on which it was granted.
- "(4) A fee of ten dollars is payable on the grant of a licence under this Act.".

# Penalties for breach of Act.

3 Section twelve of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the words "ten dollars" (twice occurring) and substituting therefor, in each case, the words "fifty dollars".

#### The schedule.

- 4 Form II in the schedule to the Principal Act is amended—
  - (a) by omitting therefrom the words "one dollar" and substituting therefor the words "ten dollars"; and
  - (b) by omitting therefrom the words and numerals "31st day of December 19" and substituting therefor the words "expiration of one year from the date on which it is granted".
