

## SECOND-HAND DEALERS.

### No. 74 of 1972.

#### AN ACT to amend the *Second-hand Dealers Act* 1905. [17 January 1973.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Second-hand Dealers Act* 1972.

(2) The *Second-hand Dealers Act* 1905, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Licensing of second-hand dealers.

**2** Section four of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsections (3) and (4) thereof and substituting therefor the following subsections:—

“(3) A licence under this Act shall, unless sooner cancelled, remain in force for a period of one year from the date on which it was granted.

“(4) A fee of ten dollars is payable on the grant of a licence under this Act.”.

Penalties for breach of Act.

**3** Section twelve of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the words “ten dollars” (twice occurring) and substituting therefor, in each case, the words “fifty dollars”.

The schedule.

**4** Form II in the schedule to the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by omitting therefrom the words “one dollar” and substituting therefor the words “ten dollars”; and

(b) by omitting therefrom the words and numerals “31st day of December 19 ” and substituting therefor the words “expiration of one year from the date on which it is granted”.
