



STAMP DUTIES AMENDMENT ACT 1981

TABLE OF PROVISIONS

1. Short title.
2. Amendment of Part I of third Schedule to *Stamp Duties Act 1931* (Instruments exempted from duty).

AN ACT to amend the Stamp Duties Act 1931 for the purpose of making further provision with respect to instruments exempted from duty.

[Royal Assent 30 September 1981]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Stamp Duties Amendment Act* Short title. 1981.

2—Part I of the third Schedule to the *Stamp Duties Act* 1931* is amended by inserting the following paragraph at the end of item 39:—

An application made by the owner of a motor vehicle, where—

(a) the hirer of the vehicle has voluntarily returned the vehicle pursuant to section 16 of the *Hire-Purchase Act* 1959; or

(b) the owner has taken possession of the vehicle pursuant to Division V of Part III of that Act,

and the owner satisfies the Commissioner that he proposes to sell or otherwise dispose of the vehicle.

In this paragraph, “hirer” and “owner” have the meanings assigned to those expressions by the *Hire-Purchase Act* 1959.
