### AN ACT to amend the Stamp Duties Act 1931.

# [Royal Assent 26 May 1988]

**B**<sup>E</sup> it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the Stamp Duties Amendment Short title. Act 1988.

2—This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on 1st Commencement. September 1976.

3—In this Act, the Stamp Duties Act 1931\* is referred to Principal Act. as the Principal Act.

Amendment of Schedule 3 to Principal Act (INSTRUMENTS EXEMPTED FROM DUTY).

4—Part I of Schedule 3 to the Principal Act is amended with respect to the exemption operating in relation to item 11 in Schedule 2 to that Act by adding at the end of the second column of that Part:—

- "Any agreement for the payment of commission, pursuant to the Auctioneers and Estate Agents Act 1959, in connection with the sale, purchase, or exchange of real property.
- Any agreement for the offering of real property for sale, purchase, or exchange made between a vendor and a person licensed under the Auctioneers and Estate Agents Act 1959.".
