AN ACT to amend the Stamp Duties Act 1931.

[Royal Assent 26 May 1988]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Stamp Duties Amendment Act 1988*. Short title.

2—This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on 1st September 1976. Commencement.

3—In this Act, the *Stamp Duties Act 1931** is referred to as the Principal Act. Principal Act.

4—Part I of Schedule 3 to the Principal Act is amended with respect to the exemption operating in relation to item 11 in Schedule 2 to that Act by adding at the end of the second column of that Part:—

“Any agreement for the payment of commission, pursuant to the *Auctioneers and Estate Agents Act 1959*, in connection with the sale, purchase, or exchange of real property.

Any agreement for the offering of real property for sale, purchase, or exchange made between a vendor and a person licensed under the *Auctioneers and Estate Agents Act 1959*.”.
