AN ACT to repeal the Silicon Development Act 1986

[Royal Assent 17 July 1991]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title

1—This Act may be cited as the Silicon Development Act (Repeal) Act 1991.

Commencement

2—This Act commences on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Interpretation

- 3-In this Act-
 - "development area" and "silicon development" have the same meaning as those expressions had in the Silicon Development Act 1986;
 - "silicon plant" means the silicon-producing plant established pursuant to the silicon development.

Repeal of Silicon Development Act 1986

4-The Silicon Development Act 1986* is repealed.

Silicon plant to be subject to Environment Protection Act 1973

- 5—For the avoidance of doubt, nothing in section 16 of the Acts Interpretation Act 1931 restricts or affects the application of the Environment Protection Act 1973 to—
 - (a) the operation of the silicon plant; or
 - (b) the development area.
