AN ACT to amend the Stamp Duties Act 1931 to provide for the payment of stamp duty on certain instruments.

[Royal Assent 21 May 1980]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—This Act may be cited as the Stamp Duties Amendment Act Short title. (No. 2) 1980.
- **2**—(1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date commencement of assent to this Act.
- (2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the date fixed by proclamation under section 2 (2) of the *Land Titles Act* 1980.

3—In this Act, the *Stamp Duties Act* 1931* is referred to as the Principal Act.

Amendment of second Schedule.

- **4**—The second Schedule to the Principal Act is amended as follows:—
 - (a) by inserting after item 15 the following item:—

Amendment of third Schedule.

5—Part I of the third Schedule to the Principal Act is amended, with respect to the exemption operating in relation to item 9 in the second Schedule, by adding in the second column of that Part the words:—

Any certificate of title prepared following a rearrangement pursuant to section 33 (13) of the *Land Titles Act* 1980 or prepared pursuant to section 33 (18) of that Act.
