3. Amendment of section 60A of the *Stamp Duties Act* 1931 (Interpretation: Division IIIA).

AN ACT to amend the Stamp Duties Act 1931 for the purpose of providing for the interest rate prescribed for Division IIIA to be prescribed by regulations rather than in the Act.

[Royal Assent 23 December 1980]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Stamp Duties Amendment Act* Short title. (No. 4) 1980.

Commence-
ment.

2—(1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.

(2) Section 3 shall commence on such date as may be fixed by proclamation.

(3) After the date of assent to this Act but before the date referred to in subsection (2), regulations may be made under the Principal Act as if section 3 had commenced, but those regulations do not take effect until that section commences.

3—Section 60A (1) of the *Stamp Duties Act 1931* is amended by omitting the definition of “prescribed rate”.
