AN ACT to amend the Senate Elections Act 1935

[Royal Assent 21 December 1989]

B^E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title

1—This Act may be cited as the Senate Elections Amendment Act 1989.

Commencement

2—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Principal Act

3—In this Act, the Senate Elections Act 1935* is referred to as the Principal Act.

Section 4 amended (Limits within which dates may be fixed)

4—Section 4 (3) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting "ninety" and substituting "100".

Section 10 amended (Power to extend time, &c.)

5—Section 10 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting "Within twenty days before or after the day appointed for the election, the" and substituting "The".
