### AN ACT to amend the *Senate Elections Act 1935*

[Royal Assent 21 December 1989]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

#### Short title

1—This Act may be cited as the *Senate Elections Amendment Act 1989*.

#### Commencement

2—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

**Principal Act**

3—In this Act, the *Senate Elections Act 1935\** is referred to as the Principal Act.

**Section 4 amended (Limits within which dates may be fixed)**

4—Section 4 (3) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting “ninety” and substituting “100”.

**Section 10 amended (Power to extend time, &c.)**

5—Section 10 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting “Within twenty days before or after the day appointed for the election, the” and substituting “The”.
