

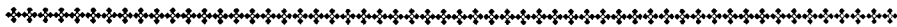


STATE EMPLOYEES (LONG-SERVICE LEAVE)

AN ACT to amend the State Employees (Long-Service Leave) Act 1950.

[30 November 1976]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *State Employees (Long-Service Leave) Act 1976*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *State Employees (Long-Service Leave) Act 1950*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Interpretation.

2 Section 2 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from paragraph (b) of the definition of "prescribed authority" in subsection (1) the word "Act" (wherever occurring) and substituting the word "enactment", in each case.

Allowances to eligible employees in certain cases.

3—(1) Section 7 of the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by inserting after paragraph (b) of subsection (1) the following paragraph:—

“(ba) resigns from his employment on account of domestic or other pressing necessity, that the prescribed authority certifies, in writing, is, in his opinion, of such a nature as to justify the employee’s resignation;”;

(b) by inserting in paragraph (e) of that subsection, after the word "employment", the words " , except pursuant to paragraph (ba)"; and

(c) by inserting in subsection (2) (a), after the word "sickness," the words " resigns from his employment pursuant to subsection (1) (ba),".

(2) This section does not apply in respect of a resignation taking effect before the commencement of this Act.

Amendments of Schedule I.

4 Schedule I to the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by omitting from the heading to the first column the words "Title of Act" and substituting the words "Title of enactment"; and

(b) by omitting the items relating to the *Tourist and Immigration Department Act 1934* and the *Education Act 1932* and substituting the following items:—

"Education Act 1932, except section 46C (1)	The Director-General of Education
"Section 46c (1) of the Education Act 1932	The Chairman of the Schools Board of Tasmania".
