AN ACT to amend the State Employees (Long-Service Leave) Act 1950 in relation to service by Government scholarship holders before 1st January 1970.

[31 August 1977]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *State Employees (Long-Service Leave) Act (No. 3) 1977*.

(2) The *State Employees (Long-Service Leave) Act 1950**, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on 28th April 1977.

2 Section 5 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsections (3B) and (3C).

Application of
amendments.

3 Where a period of continuous service is terminated before the commencement of this Act, the amendments made by this Act do not apply in respect of any service by an employee as the holder of a Government scholarship that is rendered before the termination of that continuous service.
