AN ACT to amend the State Employees (Long-Service Leave) Act 1950 so as to extend for a further period the rights to pro rata payments of certain male employees who retire voluntarily after attaining the age of 63 years.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *State Employees (Long-Service Leave) Amendment Act 1980*. Short title.

Principal Act.

2—In this Act, the *State Employees (Long-Service Leave) Act 1950** is referred to as the Principal Act.

3—Section 7 (1) (*ca*) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting “ 1980 ” and substituting “ 1981 ”.
