AN ACT to amend the Substandard Housing Control Act 1973.

[30 November 1978]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Substandard Housing Control Act 1978*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Substandard Housing Control Act 1973**, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 After section 19 of the Principal Act the following section is inserted in Part III:—

Delegation by
Director-
General.

“ 19A—(1) Subject to this section, the Director-General may delegate to all or any of the prescribed persons his powers, functions, and duties under or by virtue of this Act (except the power of delegation).

“(2) A delegation under this section—

(a) shall be by instrument in writing signed by the Director-General;

(b) shall specify the powers, functions, and duties delegated by him; and

(c) is revocable at the will of the Director-General.

“(3) Any power, function, or duty delegated to a prescribed person under this section may be exercised by that person as fully and effectually as by the Director-General and no such delegation prevents the exercise of any power, function, or duty by the Director-General.

“(4) In this section ‘prescribed persons’ means the Director, Housing Division of the Department of Housing and Construction and such officer or officers of that Division as the Director-General determines.”.
