AN ACT to revise the statute law of the State by repealing spent legislation, by correcting errors, and by altering out-of-date references.

[Royal Assent 18 January 1983]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the Statute Law Revision Act 1982. Short title.

Repeals.

2—The Acts specified in Schedule 1 are repealed.

Amendments to Acts.

- **3**—(1) Each Act specified in column 1 of Part I of Schedule 2 is amended in the manner specified opposite the reference to that Act in column 2 of that Part.
- (2) The amendments effected to the *Acts Reprinting Act* 1979 by Part I of Schedule 2 shall be deemed to have commenced on 3rd May 1979.
- (3) The amendments effected to the *Decimal Currency Act* 1965 by Part I of Schedule 2 shall be deemed to have commenced on 22nd December 1965.
- (4) The amendments effected to the *Metric Conversion Act* 1973 by Part I of Schedule 2 shall be deemed to have commenced on 19th December 1973.
- (5) Each provision of an Act listed in the first column of Part II of Schedule 2 is amended by omitting the words specified in the second column (wherever they occur in that provision) and substituting the appropriate words (if any) specified in the third column.
- (6) The amendments effected by Part II of Schedule 2 to the *Public Health Act* (No. 2) 1976 shall be deemed to have commenced on the date on which that Act received the royal assent.
- (7) The amendments effected to the *Rules Publication Act* 1953 by Part II of Schedule 2 shall be deemed to have commenced on 3rd May 1979.
- (8) Each provision of an Act listed in the first column of Part III of Schedule 2 is amended by omitting the words specified in the second column and substituting the appropriate words specified in the third column.
- (9) The amendments effected by Part III of Schedule 2 shall be deemed to have commenced on 14th February 1966.

Savings.

4—Where an Act that is repealed by this Act effected an amendment to another Act, that other Act continues in force as amended as if the Act which effected the amendment had not been so repealed.
