SCHEDULE 2

Amendment of Acts

AN ACT to revise the statute law of the State by repealing spent legislation, by correcting errors, and by altering out-of-date references.

[Royal Assent 23 May 1985]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—This Act may be cited as the Statute Law Revision Act 1985. Short title.
- **2**—Except as provided in sections 3 and 4, this Act shall commence on the day on which it receives the Royal assent.

Repeals.

- **3**—(1) The Acts specified in Schedule 1 are repealed.
- (2) This section and Schedule 1 shall commence on the day after the day on which this Act receives the Royal assent.

Amendments to Acts.

- **4**—(1) Each Act specified in column 1 of Part I of Schedule 2 is amended in the manner specified opposite the reference to that Act in column 2 of that Part.
  - (2) The amendments effected to—
    - (a) the Companies and Securities Legislation (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act 1982;
    - (b) the Corrective Services (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act 1985;
    - (c) the Hobart Regional Water Act 1984;
    - (d) the Land Titles Act 1980;
    - (e) the Long Service Leave Act 1976;
    - (f) the Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Amendment Act 1984;
    - (g) the Poisons Amendment Act 1984;
    - (b) the Racing and Gaming Amendment Act (No. 2) 1983;
    - (i) the Retirement Benefits Act 1982;
    - (j) the Statute Law Revision Act 1982; and
    - (k) the Tasmanian Development (Miscellaneous Provisions)

      Act 1983,

by Part I of Schedule 2 shall be deemed to have commenced on the day on which each of those Acts, respectively, received the Royal assent.

- (3) Each provision of an Act listed in the first column of Part II of Schedule 2 is amended by omitting the words specified in the second column (wherever they occur in that provision) and substituting the appropriate words (if any) specified in the third column.
- (4) The amendment effected to the Beauty Point Landslip Act 1970 by Part II of Schedule 2 shall commence on, or be deemed to have commenced on, the date of publication of a notice in the Gazette under section 6 of the Acts Reprinting Act 1979 declaring that the Lands Resumption Act 1957 has been reprinted, as the case requires.
- (5) The amendment effected to the Commissioner for Corporate Affairs Act 1980 by Part II of Schedule 2 shall be deemed to have commenced on 1st July 1982.

- (6) The amendment effected to the Companies Auditors and Liquidators Disciplinary Board Act 1982 by Part II of Schedule 2 shall be deemed to have commenced on 1st January 1984.
- (7) The amendment effected to the *Poisons Act* 1971 by Part II of Schedule 2 shall be deemed to have commenced on 1st January 1985.
- (8) The amendments effected to the Workers' Compensation Act 1927 by Part II of Schedule 2 shall be deemed to have commenced on 1st January 1985.
  - (9) The amendments effected to-
    - (a) the Electoral Amendment Act 1983;
    - (b) the Friendly Societies Amendment Act 1984;
    - (c) the Local Courts Amendment Act (No. 2) 1983;
    - (d) the Medical Amendment Act 1983; and
    - (e) the Tasmanian Trotting Control Board Amendment Act 1983,

by Part II of Schedule 2 shall be deemed to have commenced on the day on which each of those Acts, respectively, received the Royal assent.

- (10) The Evidence Act 1910 is amended as specified in Part III of Schedule 2.
- (11) The amendments effected to the *Evidence Act* 1910 by Part III of Schedule 2 shall commence on, or be deemed to have commenced on, the day fixed by proclamation under section 2 (2) of the *Tasmanian State Service* (*Miscellaneous Amendments*) Act 1984, as the case requires.
  - **5**—(1) Where an enactment that is repealed by this Act—

Savings.

- (a) appropriated, or authorized the expenditure of, money from the Consolidated Revenue Fund; and
- (b) authorized or required the expenditure or application of money during any 2 or more financial years,

that money may, to the extent to which it has not been expended or applied before the commencement of this Act, be expended or applied in accordance with that enactment as if that enactment had not been repealed. 786

- (2) Where an enactment that is repealed by this Act imposed or levied a tax, duty, charge, rate, or impost, and, at the commencement of this Act, the tax, duty, charge, rate, or impost thereby imposed or levied, or any part thereof, has not been paid by a person by whom it is payable, that tax, duty, charge, rate, or impost, or part thereof, as the case may be, remains payable by that person, and may be recovered accordingly, as if that enactment had not been repealed.
- (3) Where an enactment that is repealed by this Act authorized the execution or carrying out of any work or undertaking by the Governor or by a State authority or local body and, at the commencement of this Act, the execution or carrying out of that work or undertaking had not been commenced, or had been commenced but not completed, the Governor or that State authority or local body may execute or carry out that work or undertaking, or, as the case may be, complete the execution or carrying out of that work or undertaking, and may do, or continue to do, all such acts and things as may be necessary for the purposes of the execution or carrying out of that work or undertaking, as if that enactment had not been repealed.
- (4) Where an enactment that is repealed by this Act authorized the making of a loan or advance to a person or class of persons and, at the commencement of this Act, the loan or advance so made to any person has not been repaid in accordance with the requirements of that enactment, the loan or advance (together with the interest, if any, payable in respect thereof), so far as it has not been repaid, continues to be repayable in accordance with the requirements of that enactment as if that enactment had not been repealed, and any proceedings or remedies for the recovery thereof may be taken or enforced, and any securities for the repayment thereof may be realized, in accordance with the provisions of that enactment, as if that enactment had not been repealed.
- (5) Where by an enactment to which subsection (4) relates a charge was imposed on any property or any conditions were prescribed as conditions upon or subject to which the loan or advance was required to be made or repaid, then until the repayment of the loan or advance (together with the interest, if any, payable in respect thereof) that charge continues in full force and effect and may be enforced accordingly, and those conditions continue to apply, in all respects as if that enactment had not been repealed.

- (6) Where an enactment that is repealed by this Act vested any land, or any estate or interest in land, in any person (including the Crown) the repeal of that enactment does not affect the vesting of that land, or of that estate or interest, or any conditions, restrictions, obligations, or trusts imposed or created by or under that enactment in respect of the use, sale, disposal, leasing, mortgaging, or charging thereof and any conditions, restrictions, obligations, or trusts so imposed or created continue to have full force and effect and may be enforced accordingly in all respects as if that enactment had not been repealed.
- (7) Where an enactment that is repealed by this Act operated to continue any temporary Act, the repeal of that enactment does not affect the continuance or operation of the temporary Act.
- (8) Where an enactment that is repealed by this Act authorized the Governor or a State authority or local body to borrow any money for the purposes of that enactment or of any enactment incorporated therewith or with which that enactment was incorporated and, at the commencement of this Act, the whole or any part of the money so authorized to be borrowed had not been borrowed, that money or that part of that money, as the case may be, may, notwithstanding the repeal of that enactment, be borrowed and applied, in accordance with that enactment, as if that enactment had not been repealed.
- (9) Where, by or under an enactment that is repealed by this Act, any payment required by the repealed enactment to be made has not been made, or any act, matter, or thing commenced or in progress thereunder at the commencement of this Act has not been completed, that payment may be made, or, as the case may be, that act, matter, or thing may be continued and completed, as if that enactment had not been repealed.
- (10) The repeal of an enactment by this Act does not operate so as to repeal an enactment that is incorporated with the repealed enactment.
- (11) The repeal by this Act of an enactment that is incorporated with another enactment does not operate so as to repeal that other enactment.

- (12) Where by an enactment that is repealed by this Act any payment, act, matter, or thing was made or deemed to be lawful, valid, or effectual, or any person was released or discharged from any claim, action, suit, or proceeding, that payment, act, matter, or thing shall, to the extent to which it was so made or deemed to be lawful, valid, or effectual, continue to be, or to be deemed to be, lawful, valid, or effectual or, as the case may be, that person shall continue to be so released or discharged, as if that enactment had not been repealed.
- (13) The repeal by this Act of any enactment does not affect any relief or discharge from, or indemnity against, any disqualification, penalty, forfeiture, incapacity, or disability granted to, or conferred on, any person or class of persons by or under that enactment, and any such person or class of persons continues to be entitled to the benefit of the relief, discharge, or indemnity so granted or conferred in all respects as if that enactment had not been repealed.
- (14) Where an enactment (in this subsection referred to as "the amending enactment") that is repealed by this Act amended another enactment by—
  - (a) repealing, expunging, deleting, or omitting any words or numerals from the text:
  - (b) inserting, adding, or substituting any words or numerals in the text: or
  - (c) renumbering or relettering any provision,

of that other enactment, then, unless that other enactment is repealed by this Act, the repeal of the amending enactment does not affect the operation of the amendment so made, and that other enactment shall, subject to any subsequent enactment amending or modifying it, continue to be construed as if the amending enactment had not been repealed.

- (15) In subsection (14) of this section, "words" includes Part, Division, heading, section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sub-subparagraph, Schedule, and other subdivision of an enactment.
  - (16) In this section—
    - "local body" includes the council of a city or municipality, a marine board, a harbour trust, a drainage trust, and the governing body of a statutory authority (not being a State authority) having power by law to borrow money upon the security of the revenues of the authority;

"State authority" means a Minister, and any other person or body of persons, whether incorporated or unincorporated, constituted, or established by or under an Act, or appointed by the Governor under the authority of an Act or in the exercise of the prerogative rights of the Crown, to administer or control a department or business, or an undertaking, on behalf of the State.
