

ST. LEONARDS WATER.

No. 55 of 1954.

AN ACT to amend the *St. Leonards Water Act 1953*.
[10 December, 1954.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *St. Leonards Water Act 1954*. Short title, citation, and commencement.

(2) The *St. Leonards Water Act 1953* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of July 1954.

2 Notwithstanding anything contained in the Principal Act, the council may borrow such sums of money as may be necessary for the purposes of that Act, but not exceeding in the whole the total amount of money that, together with all other borrowings of the council, does not exceed the amount that may be borrowed under the provisions of section five of the *Local Bodies Loans Act 1881*. Power to borrow.

3 The Governor may guarantee the repayment of any moneys that are borrowed by the council pursuant to the Principal Act or this Act and the payment of any interest that is payable in respect thereof. Power of Governor to guarantee repayment of moneys borrowed.

4 If the Governor, in consequence of a guarantee under section three, is called upon to advance or pay a sum of money to a lender, the sum of money to be so advanced or paid shall be paid out of the Consolidated Revenue which, to the necessary extent, is appropriated accordingly; and any sum of money so paid is a first charge upon the entire funds of the corporation and the Treasurer has, and may Appropriation.

exercise in respect thereof, all or any of the powers given to the holders of securities by the *Local Bodies Loans Act 1881*.

Saving.

5 The issue by the council of a security on the revenues of the corporation or on any part thereof does not preclude or affect any sale or disposal by the council of any property of the corporation.

**CROWN LANDS (MISCELLANEOUS
PROVISIONS) (No. 2).**

No. 56 of 1954.

AN ACT to provide for the reinstatement of certain persons as purchasers of Crown land, to authorize the Governor to convey and alienate certain pieces of Crown land, to close certain roads and vest in the Crown the lands comprised within the boundaries thereof and authorize the sale of those lands by the Crown, to provide for the alteration of a certain notification relating to the acquisition of land by the Crown, and to amend the *Crown Lands (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1952* and the *Crown Lands (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1954*.
