AN ACT to amend the Sale of Blood Act 1964.

[13 December 1978]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Sale of Blood Act 1978*.

(2) The *Sale of Blood Act 1964**, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2—After section 1 of the Principal Act the following section is inserted:—

Interpretation.

1A In this Act, “ blood ” includes—

- (a) a substance derived from blood; and
- (b) an organ or any tissue, including the placenta, of a kind that is suitable as a source from which to derive a constituent of blood for therapeutic use or for the preparation of a substance for therapeutic use.
