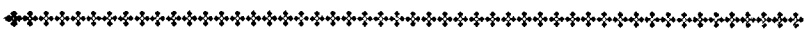

AN ACT to amend the *Sale of Goods Act 1896*.
[6 December, 1937.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Sale of Goods Act 1937*, and shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation. Short title.

2 The Principal Act is hereby amended by inserting after section sixty-two thereof the following new section sixty-three—

“**63** Any provision, express or implied, in any contract of sale of wool entered into after the commencement of this section, providing for any deduction, as or in the nature of a draft allowance, from the weight of the wool which is the subject of such contract, shall be void and of no effect.”

Expiry of
Act.

3 This Act shall expire on the date of the gazettal of a proclamation made under section eight of the *Statute Law Revision Act 1934*, effecting in the Principal Act, as from the date of such gazettal, the amendments made by this Act with such alterations, if any, as may be required to adapt the same for incorporation in the reprint of the Principal Act.
