BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Sale of Goods Act 1939*.

2 Section sixty-three of the Principal Act is hereby amended by inserting—

- (a) “(1)” at the commencement: and
- (b) “(2) Any provision, express or implied, in any contract of sale of potatoes entered into after the commencement of this subsection, providing for any deduction, as or in the nature of an allowance for tret, from the weight of the potatoes which are the subject of such contract, shall be void and of no effect.” (at the end).
