AN ACT to amend the Scenery Preservation Act 1945. 1915. [20 December, 1945.]

 B^{E} it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Scenery Preservation short title and citation.

(2) The Scenery Preservation Act 1915*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Subsection (2) of section seventeen of the Principal Act is amended-

- (a) by omitting the words "being not less than five
