

2 The Board shall be deemed to have, and always to have had, power to act as the delegate of a prescribed authority under the *Re-establishment and Employment Act 1945** of the Commonwealth, and to exercise and perform, as such delegate, such of the powers and functions of a prescribed authority under Division 4 of Part VI. of that Act as may be specified in any instrument of delegation under section seven A of that Act.

SHEFFIELD PUBLIC CEMETERY (VESTING.)

11 & 12 GEO. VI. No. 95.

AN ACT to provide for the vesting in His Majesty of certain land at Sheffield known as King George's Park Recreation Reserve, and for purposes incidental thereto. [19 December, 1947.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Sheffield Public Cemetery (Vesting) Act 1947*.

Short title and incorporation.

(2) This Act shall be incorporated with the *Crown Lands Act 1935**.

2 The land described in the schedule, known as King George's Park Recreation Reserve (in this Act referred to as "the said land") shall, on the commencement of this Act, revert to and revest in His Majesty for public purposes, freed and discharged from all estates, interests, trusts, obligations, contracts, licences, and charges, whatsoever.

Vesting of cemetery in the Crown.

3—(1) On the commencement of this Act, the rights of all persons in and to the said land and in any graves, tombs, vaults, monuments, tombstones, and other memorials therein shall wholly cease.

Rights to graves and memorials determined.

(2) The Minister shall make such arrangements as he thinks desirable for the reverent removal of the memorials referred to in subsection (1) from the said land to some suitable place.

Power to

4—(1) The Commissioner may lease the said land to the Warden, Councillors and Electors of the Municipality of Kentish, for a period not exceeding ninety-nine years, at a yearly rental of one pound.

(2) The lease of the land referred to in subsection (1) shall be subject to the condition that the said land shall be used as a public recreation ground and war memorial centre, and for no other purposes.

5 The Warden, Councillors and Electors of the Municipality of Kentish may sub-lease to the Sheffield Sub-Branch of the Returned Sailors' Soldiers' and Airmen's Imperial League of Australia for such lesser period than ninety-nine years such portion of the said land as the said Warden, Councillors and Electors may see fit for the purposes of and incidental to a war memorial centre.

Bounded on the south-east by 8 chains 5 links south-westerly along Lot 5 Section G purchased by George Pullen commencing at the north angle thereof on Albert-street on the south-west by 6 chains 2½ links north-westerly along Lot 2 Section G purchased by William Abey and Lot 1 Section G purchased by John Hilder Wedge on the north-west by 2 chains 38½ links north-easterly along High-street on the north-east by 2 chains 5½ links south-easterly in two bearings along land occupied by the Police Department on the north-west by 1 chain 96 links north-easterly in two bearings along that land and 0a. 1r. 0p. purchased by the Warden Councillors and Electors of the Municipality of Kentish on the south-west by 51 links north-westerly along the lastmentioned land on the north-west by 3 chains 50 3/10 links north-easterly along 0a. 0r. 24 4/10p. purchased by the Warden Councillors and Electors of the Municipality of Kentish and also along 0a. 1r. 21 6/10p. reserved for recreation purposes on the north-east by 3 chains 84 links south-easterly in two bearings along 0a. 1r. 27p. granted to the Commonwealth of Australia on the north-west by 2 chains 33 links north-easterly also along that land and thence on the north-east by 1 chain 87 links south-easterly along Albert-street aforesaid to the point of commencement.
