AN ACT to amend the *Statutory Salaries Act 1971*.  
[20 November 1973.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Statutory Salaries Act 1973*. Short title, citation, and commencement.
- (2) The *Statutory Salaries Act 1971*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of October 1973.
