AN ACT to amend the Statutory Salaries Act 1979 for the purpose of making provision for the salary of Solicitor-General.

[Royal Assent 29 June 1983]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Statutory Salaries Amendment Act 1983*. Short title.

2—This Act shall commence on the day on which the *Solicitor-General Act 1983* commences. Commencement.

3—The *Statutory Salaries Act 1979** is amended by inserting the following section after section 4:—

4A—The rate of salary of the Solicitor-General shall be the maximum rate of salary for a permanent head as determined in accordance with the scales of salaries laid down under an award in force under Part V of the *Public Service Act 1973*.
